IMPORTANT UPDATE REGARDING CORONAVIRUS

Dear Parents/Carers,

With the recent rise of Coronavirus, we are seeing increasing numbers of cases confirmed in schools. We have very clear plans for this eventuality and place the highest priority on the safety and wellbeing of our staff and students. Your cooperation with this is essential.

We would like to update and remind you of what to do in case of suspected and confirmed cases of the virus.

1. Suspected Cases

We would like to remind you to please **keep any students at home** who display one or more of the main coronavirus symptoms:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- the loss or change of their sense of taste or smell, or if
- they are recommended to get tested by a healthcare provider (e.g. GP or nurse)

If a student develops one or more of the main coronavirus symptoms described above, **only they** should be tested. There is no need for their households to have a test, unless they are also symptomatic. Remember that if someone in your household is displaying symptoms, **the whole household should isolate** while waiting for a test. Please do not send children from the same household to school if anyone in the family is displaying symptoms.

2. Confirmed Cases

If your child, or anyone in their household, receives a positive test, please **notify the school immediately**. Do not wait until the next school day. If you are unable to speak to someone in the school in person, **please ring the Deputy CEO of the Trust directly on the number below**, so that he can make the necessary arrangements. Please do not leave an answerphone message, or contact us by email, as this may result in a delay in our response. **Please ONLY ring this number, however, if there is CONFIRMED case in your household, and if the school is unavailable.**
