As you will know, the Government has announced an end to nearly all COVID protections. For schools, this means that students are no longer required to wear masks in classrooms with immediate effect. From next Thursday, they will also no longer be required to wear them in communal areas.

We will also continue to require students to sanitise their hands at key points, including upon arrival at school and when entering the canteen.
