Contact with someone suffering with coronavirus	<p>Follow Government advice. To maintain social distancing at all times, students will be: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allocated the school entrance/exit they may use • Allocated a zoned area of the school/classroom and the route to take to get there • Allocated a desk within each classroom • Allocated which toilet facilities they may use. • Allocated zoned area they may go to for any break period • Corridors will have a one-way system where possible or a divider down the middle to keep groups apart • It is recommended that talking face to face is avoided where possible and to do so only when at least 2m apart. If possible, sit side by side for discussions and maintain 2m. • Classes are allocated to a specific year group zone; interaction between different groups in different zones is reduced to avoid cross-contamination. • Hand sanitiser (provided by us) and hand washing to be encouraged on entry to the school and before eating. • FHS students wear masks in all communal indoor spaces, apart from during lessons. Year 6 students will also be asked to wear masks in corridors and when queuing in the canteen. Masks can be provided if needed. 	M	X

Break/lunchtime	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 30 minutes outside break provided, plus 50 minutes at lunchtime Zoned areas to be allocated for outdoor break and lunch Hand washing on entry/exit to classrooms Students will be supervised at all times to ensure mixing between groups doesn't occur, and they will be reminded about the rules throughout the day 	M	X
Toilets/washrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Designated toilets for each zone Daytime cleaners to regularly clean throughout the day and deep clean at night Regular checks of soap and hand sanitiser throughout the day 	M	X
Outdoor recreational areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Areas to be zoned for each year group Maintain social distancing and to limit any inter-group interaction Equipment games to be limited to year group only and equipment sanitised between uses, e.g football, tennis, badminton and table tennis due to cross contamination. If students bring their own equipment, this must not be touched by anyone else 	M	X
