It is my pleasure to invite your child to take part in a Webcast hosted by the Holocaust Educational Trust on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> January. This has been organised to provide a unique opportunity to hear from a Holocaust Survivor about the events that happened during the 1930's and 40's across Europe, and links into the school's History curriculum.



During this webcast, students in years 9 to 11 will hear the story of Eve Kugler B.E.M, who will tell us about her time living in Germany during the 1930's, fleeing to Paris in 1939 and then finding eventual refuge in New York, USA. This is truly a unique opportunity as the number of survivors is decreasing, therefore we must make the most of these opportunities to engage with the past.

This webcast will take place at **10am on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> January**. Your child's teachers have been notified and are aware that this session will take place during their usual lesson times for their subjects. The session will take approximately 1 hour.
